

Keeping in view the expanded business/responsibilities of the Corporation, we require dynamic professionals for the post of **Chief Program Manager/ Additional Chief Program** for our Regional Offices- Shillong, Itanagar and potentially other state headquarters of North East, for a period of two years. This office will coordinate, liaise & manage all activities pertaining to the core business operations of the Corporation and coordinate the implementation of the Govt. schemes in the state. This would require close coordination & collaboration with the State Government, GENCO, TRANSCO, DISCOMS of North eastern states, financial institutions and other power-sector players involved in the development of power sector. The incumbent should have an exposure & experience in handling State/Centre Government schemes in the power sector.
